The aim of the study course is to improve students' knowledge about the Russian postmodernism theory and basis art texts. The special attention is given theoretical to discussions about a problem of a postmodern. The rate provides active participation of students in discussion of the newest clauses and the analysis of texts.

Learning Outcomes

Students discuss and compare different processes of modern literature in the context of Postmodernism, choose and use different methods in their analysis. Students carry out an innovative research on complex peculiarities of modern literary processes and discuss its results.
